Gregory Elliott, has been making and exhibiting sculpture for the past 30 years. He holds 3 degrees including a BFA from Stephen F. Austin State University with concentrations in Commercial Art, Printmaking and Ceramics; an MA from Stephen F. Austin majoring in Ceramic Sculpture and he received his MFA from Southern Methodist University majoring in Sculpture. Elliott was the first Artist in Residence for the Ysleta Independent School District in El Paso, Texas from 1980 to 1983 and was a faculty member at Louisiana State University (LSU) from 1988 to 2002. While at LSU he served as both the Coordinator of Graduate Studies and the Area Head of Sculpture for the Art Department. From 2002 to 2008 Elliott served as chairperson for the Department of Art at the University of Texas at El Paso. Currently, Gregory Elliott is a professor of Art and Department Chairperson at the University of Texas at San Antonio.
