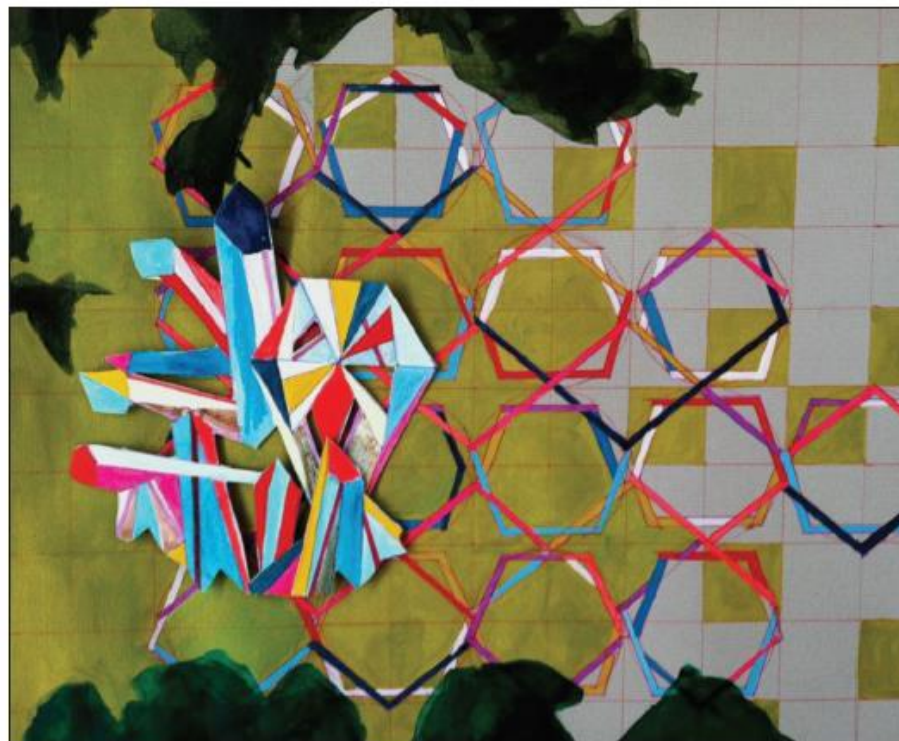




*Erin Elizabeth

A native of Albany, New York, **Erin Elizabeth Curtis** currently lives and works in Austin, Texas. She attended The Glasgow School of Art in 1998 and graduated from William College in 1999 with a BA in Liberal Arts. In May, 2007, she received her MFA from the University of Texas in Austin and she attended the Skowhegan School of Painting and Sculpture in 2010. She has had solo shows at Champion Contemporary and at Women and Their Work Gallery, both in Austin, at Lawndale Art Center in Houston and at Kashi Art Gallery, Kochi, Kerala, India. In 2008-2009, Erin was a Fulbright Scholar in Jaipur, Rajasthan. She was in residence at Anderson Ranch in Snowmass, CO, this past winter. This year's exhibit marks the first time in the history of the Kemp's Sculpture Garden that a piece created collaboratively has been shown as Erin and Scott Proctor have worked as partners to create their sculpture.
